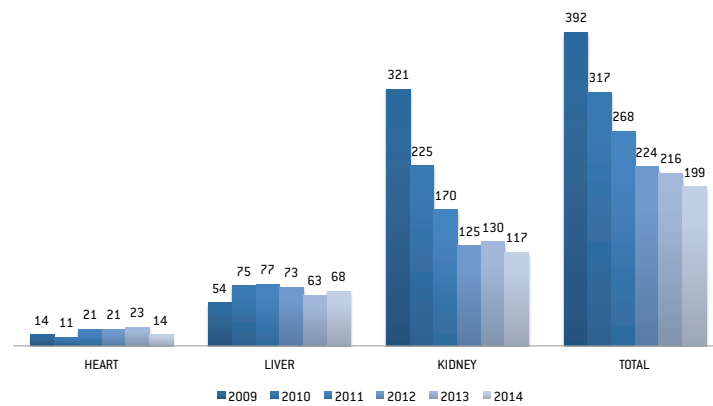
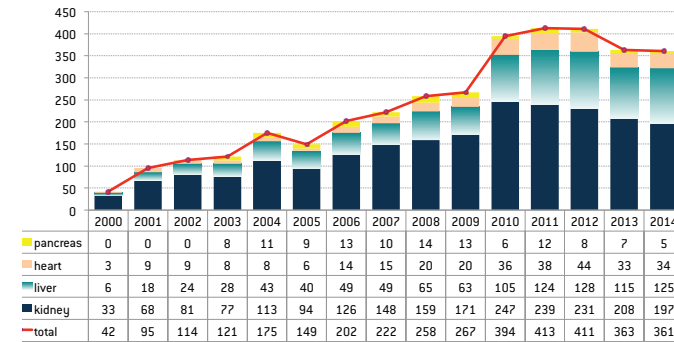


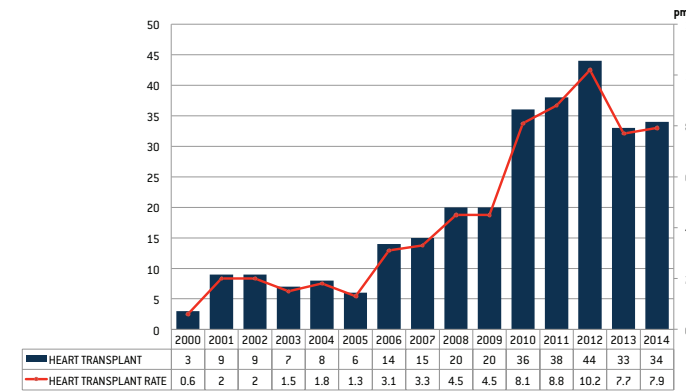
WAITING LIST 2009. - 2014. (status on 31st December)

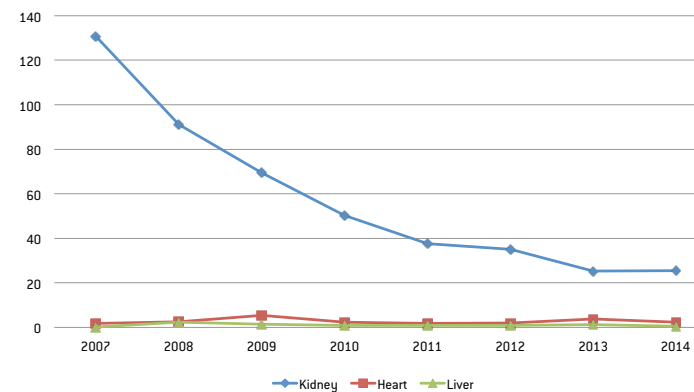

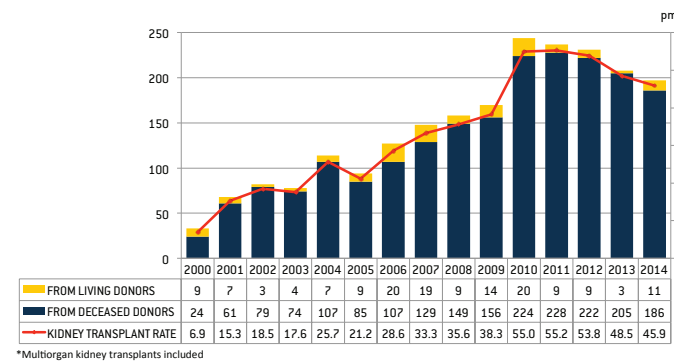

MEDIAN MONTHS WAITING FOR TRANSPLANTATION



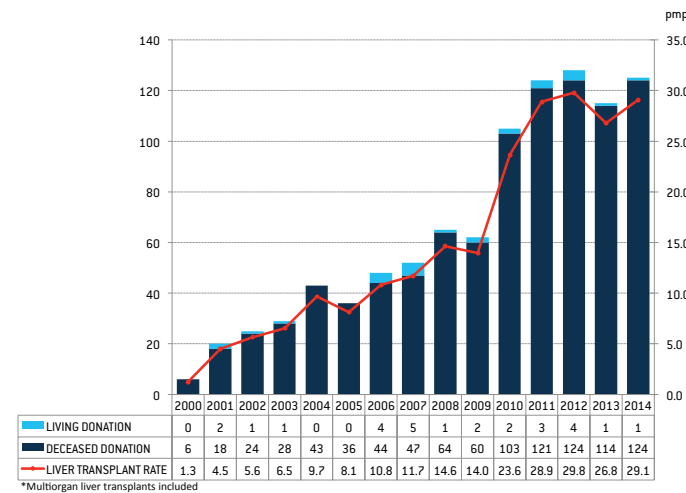

We hereby wish to thank all the employees participating in the implementation of the National Transplant Programme. We express our special appreciation to hospital transplant coordinators for their hard work and efforts in timely detection and realisation of organ donors.

Owing to the noble decision to donate organs (144 donors), 354 people received the “gift of a new life” in 2014. 361 organs were transplanted, out of which 197 kidneys, 125 livers, 34 hearts and 5 pancreases.

On behalf of all patients, we wish to thank donors and their families, whose selfless act has given them a second chance for life. Their courage and generosity are an inspiration to us all.

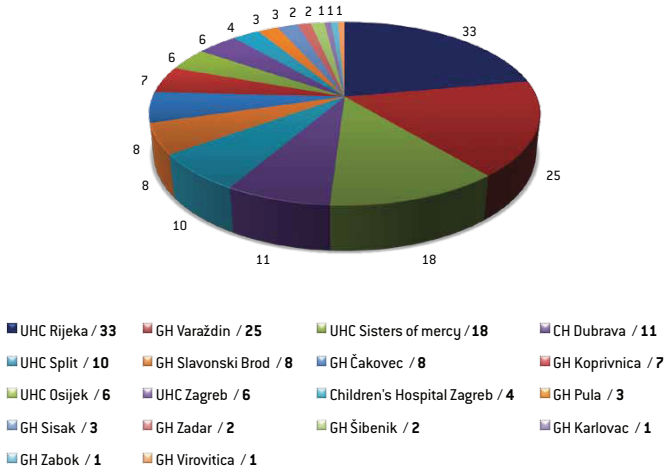

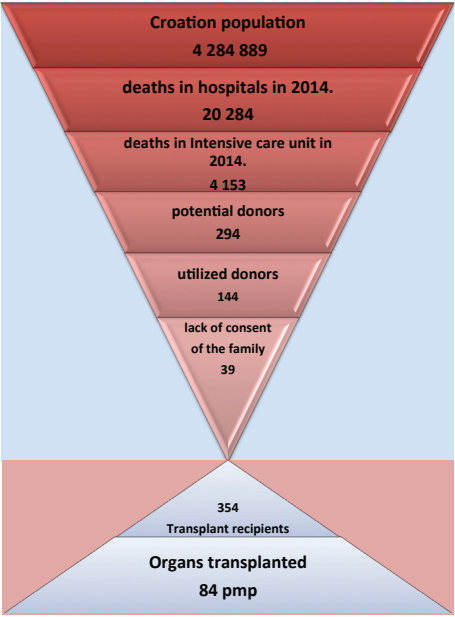

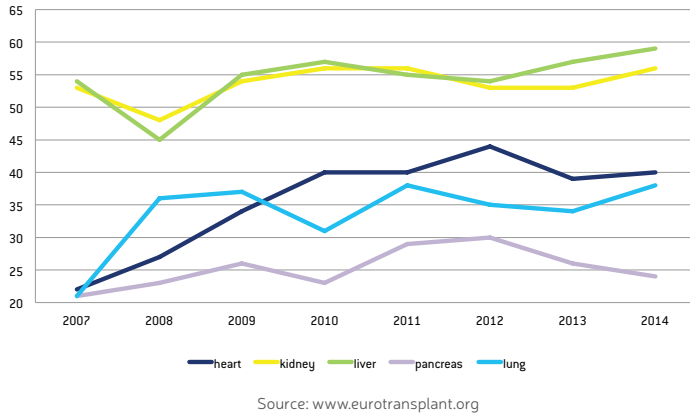
NUMBER OF ACTUAL* DONORS IN HOSPITALS IN 2014.



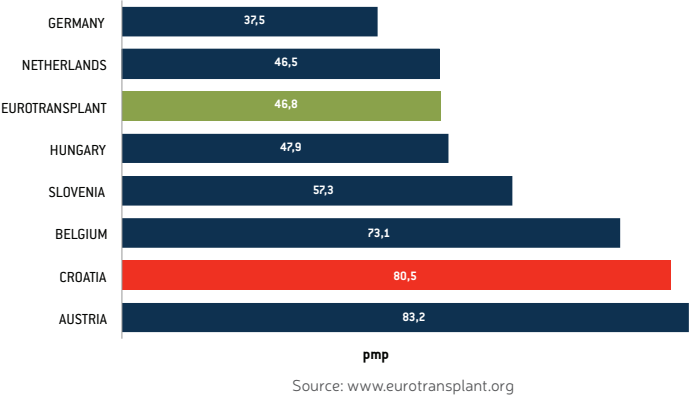

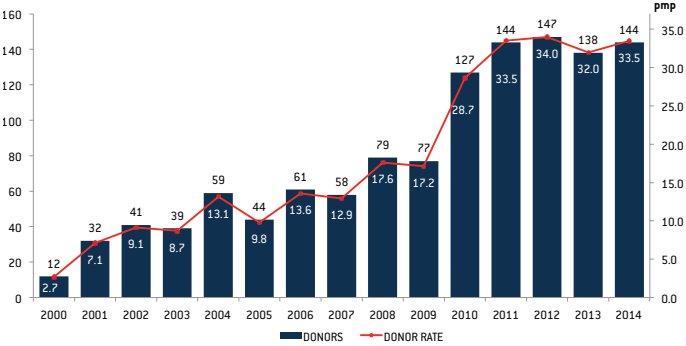
DECEASED DONORS USED IN CROATIA, BY MEDIAN AGE, BY YEAR, BY ORGAN



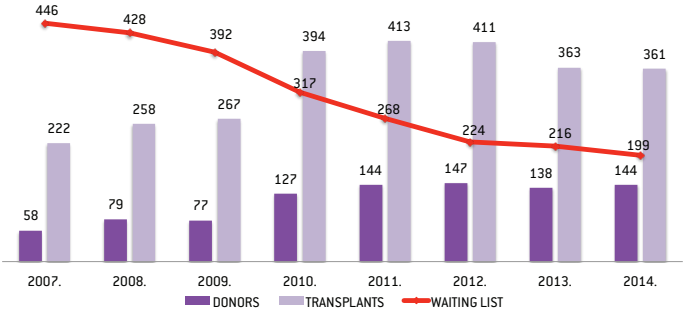
TRANSPLANT RATE IN EUROTRANSPLANT 2014.



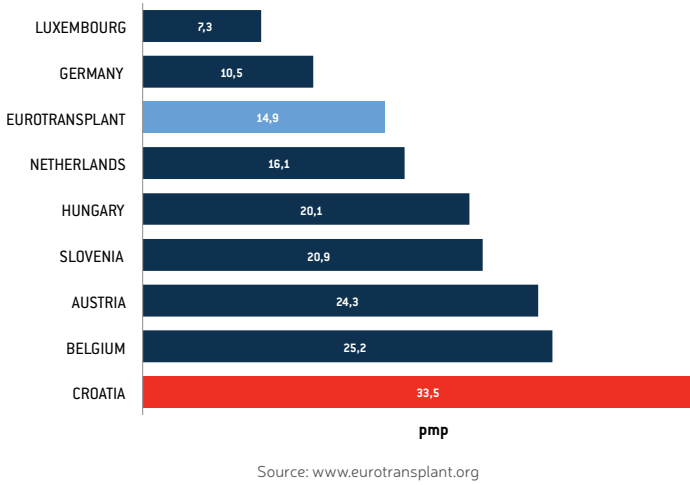
NUMBER OF UTILISED* DONORS AND DONOR RATE 2000. - 2014.
